YOUR PLACE

I have set before you an open door, and no one can shut it. Revelation 3:8

There is an appointed place for you. It is God's place. Man did not give it to you and man cannot take it away.

God has provided an opened door into His appointed place for you (that also means there is a door that God has closed to you that cannot be opened by you or anyone else.)

Walk through His open door, step completely through it with the confident strides of faith. Stay put in His place and don't pine for something different, thrive there and abide there. It is His perfect place for you.
