Please, please when the Lord lays someone on your heart, send their applications in early. We want everyone He wants to be on the weekend. So for you new Pescadores and as a reminder to the oldies but goodies the steps to sponsorship are:

Pray. Listen to what God tells you. Pray. Approach the potential candidate and ask if they would like to come. If they are hesitant, bring them to a sequela so they can meet some of the community. Answer their questions honestly, don't tease, this is a serious encounter with our Lord.

Send in their application. It can be done through the NFTD.org website or you can mail it directly to us. Please do not tell your potential candidate they are going before you hear from us, please do not send money with their applications or pay at team meetings. Payment needs to be made at sendoff. It is very confusing when money has gone to several different people, especially if the "regulars" for sendoff check-in aren't there to record the payments.

When you receive the letter stating your candidate has been invited, please make sure they send the reservation form back promptly. The reservation form is their confirmation information and if it is not returned, they are not confirmed. We try to let sponsors know when their candidates are confirmed, but if you don't hear from us, please call. Sometimes, applications and reservations forms get lost in email land or the postal service.

When your candidate has been confirmed, please begin to gather their letters and continue to encourage them.

Bring them to sendoff. Look after their family while they are away. Pick them up at closing. Love on them. Get them in a reunion group.

If your candidate must drop, please let us know as soon as possible. We usually have someone who is waiting on a spot that we can fill in with.

Continue to pray.
