

Father, we ask for your mighty hedge of protection around each and everyone who is a part of these weekends. We claim victory in the mighty name of JESUS! Amen.




NFTD #56 From our Rectors Hearts:

Sponsorship

It's not too late to sponsor someone for Weekend #56! Please keep in mind that couples need to make the same weekend. Applications can be found on NFTD.org, and they will be accepted up to Send-Off if space is available for additional candidates. If you have prayed about sponsoring someone, and they are ready/willing to make this weekend, please contact us directly (850-284-1657) due narrow time frame. We will contact those individuals by phone.

Remember, that there are responsibilities as a sponsor. Making sure the weekend fees are taken care (either by the sponsor or make sure candidate is aware of what the fees are - \$110.00), and know they are due at Send-Off. Get the candidate to Send-Off, and pick them up after Closing at the campground. Make sure they know what items they will need to bring. Reassure your candidate that you will watch over things on the home front (this could mean husband/wife, kids, pets, etc.) so they don't need to be concerned about those things while they are on their weekend. Most of all PRAY, PRAY, and PRAY! Pray up until Send-Off, during the weekend, and pray for them on their 4th Day.

After the weekend, be there for them on their 4th Day. Encourage them to attend our Victory Sequela, get involved with a Reunion Group, and again PRAY. Remember the emotional high you had on your weekend, and the challenges that can come on the 4th Day.

- Tables Individual
- ~48 (50+) Candidates & Professors
- Rollo Room
- ~52 (55+) Tables + SD + Rector
