2018 - Back to the Fundamentals

So NFTD will THRIVE toward Abba Father...

Mission: "To bring Christians to a closer, more personal walk with their Lord Jesus Christ and encourage them to Christian leadership and apostolic action..."

This Mission is to direct us every day of our 4th day.

- 1. "To bring" First we must bring ourselves closer to Abba Father and then have relationships with other Christians, to know which ones God wants us to bring closer to Him.
- 2. "Christians" Those currently having faith in the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- 3. "Closer, more personal walk" Daily study His Word during the journey that brings joy, and in prayer of gratitude (simply talk to Him)
- 4. "With their Lord Jesus Christ" He is our Savior, provider, and He chooses to walk with us every moment of every day regardless what we are walking through. When we look back the only footprints we may see is His, while He was carrying us through those times in our life.
- 5. "Encourage them" Be a broken vessel that God can freely pour His love through you and into others.
- 6. "To Christian Leadership" Allow and have the desire to grow in Christian leadership, then grow and teach His people (Christians) to be the Christian leader that He created them to be.
- 7. "And apostolic action" Choose to make fruit in others' lives, choose to put your time, treasures and talents into others so that Abba Father will receive the glory. These three gifts of time, treasures and talents are from Abba Father. He has more to give. So, give freely...

For a 4th day movement to "thrive," its people need to be in a reunion group of some type. Proverbs 15:22 (HCSB) 22 Plans fail when there is no counsel, but with many advisors they succeed. For the 4th day movement was formed from a reunion group.

Sponsorship can be easier through a reunion group, for many hands make light work. Sponsorship has accountability when it comes from a reunion group. For example, a reunion group can serve as "many advisors" when prayerfully deciding on whom to sponsor, and how to sponsor.

How do we measure a THRIVING 4th day movement -

- We receive our direction for daily living through Abba Father and His Word,
- There is fruit made through us to others in Jesus' name,
- We are willing to counsel others and be counseled by others in reunion groups,
- That our pastors, elders and general church body see us producing fruit with our time, treasures and talents that are put into actions for the glory of God.

The act of sponsorship starts with prayer above all else. We all know that the whole world would benefit from a Tres Dias experience, but the reason this works so well for people is because God is in it, with it, and controlling it. So please pray before you even talk to someone to make sure that this is their weekend, because if it's not, they are not going to receive what God intends for them. Tres Dias, or one of our sister movements, may not be the tool that God will use to show them who He is, and how much He loves them. Bathe them and yourself in prayer. Our Community is not about filling the chairs around tables. It's about doing the work of our Father, and being our Jesus' hands and feet. We can't say enough about praying before you even approach someone about Tres Dias, but if Daddy speaks loud and clear to you "Hey I want that one to go through," then by all means go get 'em.

Once we receive an application, we will send the sponsor a letter letting them know that their candidate has been sent an invitation to attend the next Tres Dias. It is at that point that the sponsor really needs to start praying for the candidate. Sponsors should check in with their candidate, and ask them if they still want to go. If they do, help them send the reservation form back in. Remember, they do not have a spot on the weekend until we have that reservation form in hand. So help them, encourage them, to get that back into us straight away!

The weekend fees are \$120.00, and is due at send-off. If the sponsor is paying their candidate's way, great, but if not remind them the fee is \$120.00, and that is due at send-off. Do not embarrass the candidate at send-off by not having this understood prior to send-off.

Make sure your Candidate is secure in knowing that while they are away, you as their sponsor, will be, or you will have someone else be, available to help with what goes on at home. This is just another way to help them, "Let go and Let God." This will also help the wife to know that, while her husband is away, we didn't whisk her husband away just to leave her holding the bag; so to speak. This could leave a bad taste in her mouth, and she may not receive what Daddy has for her. Sponsors you need to be there for the spouse and family (or make sure someone else has it covered) whatever their needs may be...childcare, pets, etc. Be at closing to take them home after their weekend. Don't just assume someone will get them home. It is your responsibility to get them home after their weekend. On their fourth day make sure that you continue to pray for them, and that you continue to support them in their Christian walk! When you sponsor someone it is now your responsibility to be there for them!
