Practical Pronouncements from the Preweekend Couple

Greetings from the Preweekend Couple! We bless you, in the name of Jesus! We would like to take a moment to share a few details regarding characteristics of the sponsor and the candidate, as outlined in our North Florida Policies and Practices Manual.

The Sponsor:

It is essential that each sponsor understand that s/he is responsible for sponsoring a candidate for participation in all phases of the Tres Dias movement, not just the Weekend. The sponsor has the responsibility of maintaining an ongoing relationship with his/her candidate/pescadore and encouraging his/her participation in sequelas, reunion groups, and serving on Weekends. The sponsor must also be a member of a Tres Dias community or similar community recognized as equivalent by Tres Dias.

The Candidate:

Recognizing that Tres Dias is a Christian movement, each candidate must be a professing Christian who has a desire for a closer relationship with Jesus Christ as his/her Lord and Savior. Candidates shall be accepted from all Christian denominations, as well as independent Christian works. Each candidate shall be at least 21 years of age with the exception of a married couple, where one spouse is over 21 and one is under 21. In such case, the underage spouse shall also be accepted for any Weekend that he 21 year old spouse would be eligible to attend.

We hope you find this information helpful, as you consider possibly sponsoring any potential candidates in the future!
