We are in the process of trying to help streamline a position on the secretariat. As many of you know, the weekend couple is responsible for a lot. After doing some research as to what other communities are doing about this position, we are going to split this into 2 positions called Procurement Couple and Weekend Coordinator Couple.

The **Procurement Couple** will be responsible for the following:

Transports supplies to weekends and takes care of the storage of supplies between weekends. Maintains one of the enclosed trailers.

Acts as liaison with the onsite campground director

Maintains a master supply and equipment list with an inventory of assets.

Purchases and maintains assets and supplies.

Participates in the overall guidance and planning of NFTD activities.

The **Weekend Coordinator Couple** will be responsible for the following:

Acts as liaison with the onsite campground director

Identifies Pescadores to serve on set up and take down crews to help with set up and take down of all equipment

In charge of cleaning the campground at the completion of each weekend

Transports equipment to and from the weekend site. Maintains one of the enclosed trailers.

Responsible for all setup and trailer materials

Hauls luggage from Tallahassee (sendoff) to the campground

The **Procurement Couple** will be a voting member of the Secretariat. Once voted on, this position would take place immediately after the community vote in June and will serve the rest of 2023 through 2025.

The following people have been submitted for the upcoming positions and are being put up as potential Secretariat members. They will assume their positions in January, 2024. We will confirm this by a community vote at the June Sequela meeting which will be announced later.

These are just questions for you to think through as you are praying about possible sponsorship.
 - Is the potential candidate able to physically endure sitting for long periods of time and traveling to multiple locations?
 - Does the potential candidate exhibit, or have the ability to exhibit, leadership qualities? Especially within his/her church?
 - Is the potential candidate actively seeking a deeper relationship with Jesus?
 - Have you known the candidate long enough to speak to his/her character in Christ?
 - Will you be able to mentor and/or provide support after the weekend has concluded should your candidate need your assistance walking out his/her Fourth Day?
- Again, please note, these questions are simply prayer points to consider as you are talking with the Lord. Remember, "the ultimate objective of the Tres Dias Movement is to strengthen and extend the Body of Christ" (The Essentials of the Movement, 2.1). Thus, we want to do our part in equipping you, so that, in turn, you can equip others to become all that Jesus has called them to be.
